One is a work simple in definition and execution. As a warm-up to the Solo Photo Book Month challenge, I decided to put my very limited knowlege of Scribus, my chosen desktop publishing software, and some constraints to see if I could come up a book.

The constraints:

- * One Location: Susan Harwood Garden, UNC Charlotte
- * One hour to shoot.
- * One area to shoot (about 50 square feet maximum)
- * One Camera: Nikon D2x
- * One Lens: Tamron 90 mm f/2.8
- * One aperture: f/2.8
- * One CF card - To make things interesting I shot raw, giving me a maximum of 100 shots!
- * One hour elapsed time to choose, assemble, and publish a PDF.

So, this is that work. I hope that you enjoy it. Certainly, it's not polished, but it's just my version, today, of what can be done in one hour. I enjoyed making it!

One was edited using Lightroom. As I was severely constrained for time, I could only pick the photos, add a bit of saturation, and decide, intuitively which order to arrange them.

I used Scribus, a open-source desktop publishing software to put it together into what you see here. The general format of the book is 8x8 inches, or 576 x 576 points. The borders of the book are of the style Gutenberg, which sets the header, footer, and gutter margins to be aesthetically pleasing and of the same dimensions of the Gutenberg bible. I find it quite pleasing.

Regarding the font, it is Garamond Regular, a very easy to read, somewhat casual font good for this type of book
